Terms of Membership

- By signing the Pickering Fishery Association membership application form and/or on becoming a member, you agree to the PFA holding sufficient personal information data for the Secretary and Treasurer to maintain membership details and records, also for them and other approved members of the PFA to contact you for the purpose of keeping you informed of PFA activities and news. This includes items from third parties that in the opinion of the committee may be of general interest in accordance with the PFA Data Protection Policy.
- Admission to membership will be by the way of a reference to the 'Application for Membership' form and or by the way of an interview by the membership committee, who will be empowered to accept or reject applications, without giving reasons for so doing. Membership will be offered, unless two or more of the committee members present vote against it.
- 3. The successful candidates to be notified by email from the Secretary or Membership Secretary.
- 4. It would be preferable, though not essential, if a member of the Association sponsors the applicant.
- 5. The applicant must hold a current rod licence.
- 6. The applicant must give details of any angling clubs of which he/she is, or has been a member in the past, along with the name and address (if known) of an official of the club(s) concerned.
- 7. The applicant must give details of any angling offences committed in the past i.e. fishing without a licence, failing to produce a licence, etc.
- 8. The applicant must be aware that it is a condition of membership that he/she must attend a minimum of 4 work parties per season.
- 9. The applicant is required to have read and understood the full set of Rules, By-laws, Health and Safety and Communication Policies. These are available on the Association's web site and must be adhered to at all times.
- 10. The car sticker, lapel badge and the key issued for access to the Association's fishing are the property of the Association, and must be returned to the Secretary if the member resigns his/her membership, with any outstanding surcharges owing.
